FY22 By the Numbers

Over the last year, Roswell Inc supported 75 business retention and expansion projects and 77 recruitment and attraction projects. Of those, 43 projects were completed and 66 projects are still ongoing. Roswell Inc also worked on more than 150 business development projects and conducted 118 ombudsman engagements. Through these efforts, Roswell Inc helped to create or retain more than 1,230 jobs.


Ombudsman Support

Roswell Inc's ombudsman program is designed to help businesses navigate City Hall's policies and procedures, making sure they ask the right questions, get connected to the right people, and get their business open or project completed on time.

When this involves a construction project or buildout, the program includes Roswell Inc staff attending pre-application meetings in Community Development with a business, walking them through the process, making sure they meet deadlines, and providing strategic counsel to businesses along the way.




The Artillery Room

The Artillery Room is the result of the resilient ambition and focus of owners Pat Rains and Brian Borngesse, who also co-founded Roswell's first brewery Gate City.

Offering 3,700 square feet of newly renovated space. The Artillery Room brings a unique craft cocktail experience to the heart of Historic Roswell. Adjacent to the brewery and behind the roll-up garage door on Canton Street, patrons can enjoy The Artillery Room's house-made, on-tap craft cocktails in the upstairs loft seating or outdoor terrace. This innovative space also acts as the Canton Street gateway to the Gate City "Compound".

With its historic charm, original brick walls, exposed beams, gallery art, and ambient lighting, The Artillery Room has already become a local favorite.

Enterprise Super Store

In late 2021, Enterprise car rental was approved to redevelop the 3.4 acres on Alpharetta Highway to use for car rentals and sales. The super center will house offices, a vehicle showroom, auto repair center, used car sales, and vehicle & commercial truck rentals.

Following conditions from Roswell City Council, the new property will be landscaped with a streetscape to block the view of cars for sale from the main road. This property has been vacant since 2015, and Enterprise's new location has been noted as a "good business model for what has been a difficult [location]".

Signs of Significance

Family owned Signs of Significance is an independent signage design, fabrication, installation and service business. They opened their doors in Roswell in November 2015, and after purchasing the assets of Apex Signs and Graphics in Alpharetta, they needed a larger space. Signs of Significance considered leaving Roswell, but with the help of Roswell Inc and its REsimplifi site selection tool, Signs of Significance found and moved into its new larger location in July 2021. Since their expansion, the company has increased its sales by more than 50%.

West Alley Mixed-use Development

Anticipated to open in 2024, West Alley mixed-use development is designed to serve as a destination brand, catalyzing long-term economic growth for the City of Roswell and the Roswell Historic District. The development occupies 2.5 acres and is conveniently located in the heart of Roswell's Historic District, at the corner of Mimosa Boulevard and Magnolia Street.

An estimated \$90-million investment, West Alley will offer an outdoor alley and walkable, natural green space for outdoor gatherings, festivals and community events. Additional project features include over 40,000 square feet of office space, 16,000 square feet of boutique retail space and approximately 400 parking spaces, including 100 free for public use.

West Alley will be anchored by Kimpton Hotel, part of IHG Hotels & Resorts' Luxury & Lifestyle Collection, offering 125 guest rooms, including 20 suites, nearly 6,500 square feet of indoor meetings and events space, an 11,000-square-foot courtyard, fitness center, pool, rooftop bar, and restaurant.

Hospitality Industry

The hospitality industry is one of Roswell's largest, with more than 170 independent, locally-owned or chef-driven restaurants. The industry employs nearly 4,500 people and generates approximately \$230 million in annual sales. Roswell Inc's industry support programs—Roswell Restaurant Week and Summer Sippin'—help to drive traffic and sales to this segment of the city's economy.

Economic Development Alliance

Launched in 2016, Roswell Inc's Economic Development Alliance (EDA) is comprised of key stakeholders invited from the Roswell business community who are committed to investing in the economic growth and prosperity of the city. The group includes representatives from the city's largest employers, key regional businesses, economic development agencies and real estate development companies.

In FY22, EDA members participated in bi-monthly economic development meetings that each featured a guest speaker. This year's discussion topics included a transportation update, a look at key industries such as automotive, and site tours including recent expansion project Honda Carland and new Roswell-based headquarters GreyOrange. As of 2022, 32 companies are members of Roswell Inc's Economic Development Alliance.



































































State of the City 2022

Roswell Inc held its annual State of the City luncheon on Friday, March 25, 2022 at the Country Club of Roswell. Sponsored by over 115 companies and attended by more than 350 guests, this was Roswell Inc's largest State of the City to date. At this annual event, local businesses, community stakeholders and civic leaders come together to hear a state-of-the-city update from the Mayor of Roswell followed by an economic update from Roswell Inc. Attendees also have the opportunity to network and mingle, furthering business opportunities in the city.

One of the most anticipated portions of Roswell Inc's presentation is looking at what's to come in the year ahead. Roswell Inc announced that the hotel located at Southern Post will be a Hyatt managed by Indigo Road Hospitality Group with 125 rooms, 2 restaurants including a rooftop bar, and an estimated completion date of late 2023. Stroud also announced that GM Innovation Center plans to hire 450 new employees by the fourth quarter of 2022, making them Roswell's largest employer. Lastly, Wellstar North Fulton Hospital is investing \$9.6-million to expand its cancer center program over the next year. The comprehensive center will house surgical, medical and radiation oncology, and a multi-million-dollar CyberKnife system.
